

# **PUBLIC NOTICE**

## **DEPARTMENT FOR TRANSPORT TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990**

The Secretary of State gives notice of an Order made under Section 247 of the above Act entitled "The Stopping up of Highway (North East) (No.2) Order 2020" authorising the stopping up of an irregular shaped area of The Kingfisher carpark and an irregular shaped area of unnamed highway to the west of Holborn at Spennymoor, in the County of Durham to enable development as permitted by Durham County Council, reference DM/19/03233/FPA.

Any person aggrieved by or desiring to question the validity of or any provision within the Order, on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the above Act or that any requirement or regulation made has not been complied with, may, within 6 weeks of 28 January 2020 apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision included.
