Signage will be placed along the High Street, highlighting the different sections of the parade and stewards will be on hand to assist the Parade Marshall.

It is also asked that on attendance at the War Memorial a channel is left clear in the centre to allow wreath holders easy access to the War Memorial. Those laying wreaths and crosses are asked to access the War Memorial via the front gate and leave by the rear gate to allow a steady and respectful flow.
