Opening Times: The cemetery gates are open as follows:

- From 1st October- 31st March Opening and Closing of both Cemeteries on Saturday and Sunday 8am and 4pm and closing on Friday's at 4pm.
- From 1st April- 30th September Opening and Closing of both cemeteries on Saturday and Sunday 8am and 8pm and closing on a Friday at 8pm.

PEDESTRIAN ACCESS

The main gate into the Cemetery is open during normal working hours and weekends.

The Cemetery has been designed to be accessible and suitable to all users and provides wheelchair accessible pathways which run through the cemetery.

VEHICULAR ACCESS

Vehicular access is permitted for visitors when entering the cemetery to attend a burial plot.

Visitors should use the tarmac roads and take care not to drive/park onto the prohibited areas.

The Cemetery has car parking facilities for a maximum of 3 cars in the turning circle at the top of the cemetery access road. A new roadway has been created to enable the funeral cortege to leave the Cemetery via the exit on South View.

For safety purposes the speed limit within the cemetery grounds is 10mph.

MEMORIAL GARDENS

The walled Memorial Gardens were designed specifically for the placement of cremated remains.

The gardens situated within Spennymoor Cemetery provide a peaceful environment within the Cemetery for a quiet contemplation.

Many families see the Memorial Gardens as being their tranquil place of positive thought and meaning, a place to share one's feelings and emotions and to remember and reflect.

WHAT THE MEMORIAL GARDEN OFFERS

Choice of Memorial

The garden offers two types of memorials for families:

A wall mounted plaque may be purchased to commemorate a person whose ashes have been interred into the Memorial Garden or those that have been scattered elsewhere.

Vase blocks with memorial plaques are also available.

The memorials are available to lease for a period of ten years and are renewable after ten years if required.
