That this Council:

1. Recognises the significant achievements of Middlestone Moor FC, having progressed from a Sunday pub team to a multi-team Club, with the first-team competing in the Wearside Second Division, the 13th tier of the FA Pyramid, and commits to working with the club constructively to identify ground grading requirements for their continued success;
2. Acknowledges that the current state of repair of the changing facilities adjacent to the Albion Street football pitch, with no access to heated water, is far from ideal in the context of this success; and
3. Undertakes to hire a 4 Bay shower trailer for the remainder of the football season (from w/c 3rd March 2025 for a period of 11 weeks to Sunday 18th May 2025), at a cost of £350 per week, plus a delivery and collection fee of £300.
